## ACCESS TO FOOD

Increase access to healthy food for all individuals in Marion and Polk counties



- ◊ **Direct Access & Food Distribution**  
Ensure the communities of Marion and Polk counties have a strong network of community-based distribution partners that meet their nutritional needs.
- ◊ **Government Support Programs**  
Maximize enrollment and use of federal and state support programs aimed at alleviating hunger and poverty.
- ◊ **Individual Resiliency**  
Increase individuals' resiliency and self-reliance by providing nutrition education, work experience and training, leadership experience, and other skills that help alleviate food insecurity.
