Please keep these things in mind when visiting a pantry:

Do I qualify for food?

You are eligible for free food from a food pantry if you meet the USDA's 2022 Income Eligibility Guidelines (shown below) or if you currently receive: SNAP, WIC, TANF, Free & Reduced Lunch, SSDI, SSI, and/or LIHEAP.

What should I bring to a food pantry?

You do not need to bring anything but yourself to a pantry. You do not need to bring any form of ID or proof of income, address, or citizenship to receive food.

Can someone else pick up food for me?

All of our pantries accept a form called the Authorized Representative Form. This form can be completed prior to sending someone to receive a food box on your behalf. The form is available at: www.marionpolkfoodshare.org/ get-help/authorized-representative-form/

What information does a food pantry collect from me?

When getting free food from a food pantry, you will need to provide your name, city or zip code, and number of people in your household. Some of our pantries use a more in-depth intake program called Link2Feed or ask other questions, but providing this additional information is not required to receive free food.

How often can I get food?

Each pantry is different, but some pantries request that you come for food only one time per month.

What and how much do you get in a food box?

Typically, you will receive a variety of fresh produce. dairy, protein and shelf-stable products. Food items vary each month and generally supply a minimum of 3-5 days' worth of food.
